COLOUR

Dark red with ruby edge.

NOSE

Dark berries and plums. A little vanilla and hint of mint from oak.

PALATE

Full flavour and full body. Rich dark fruits with a little chocolate. Plentiful, fine tannins match the rich flavours.

FOOD PAIRING

This generously flavoured wine reflects the excellent vintage in McLaren Vale and may be cellared beyond 2028. Enjoy it with flavoursome red meat dishes or char-grilled vegetables.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were harvested in the cool conditions of night and then destemmed, yielding mostly whole berries for the fermenters. There, they fermented for seven days under temperature control. After pressing, the wine underwent malolactic fermentation in tank and was then transferred to French oak barrels for 15 to 18 months.
